7. Conducting market surveys and feasibility reports through projects assigned to the students and providing them to the industry for their benefit.

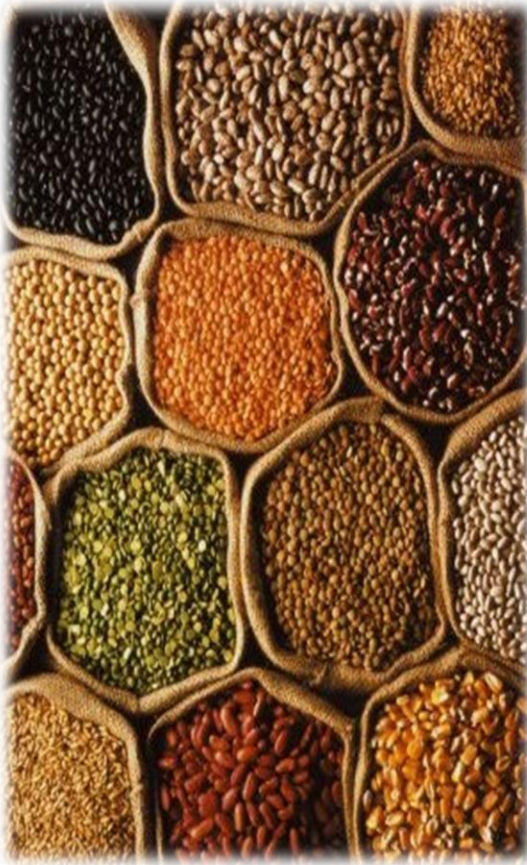
