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HANDOVER OF UMISAGAR PERCOLATION TANK TO VILLAGE ATIT



Excavation of a percolation tank at Atit, Taluka Khandala, dist. Satara was undertaken by YouthBuild Foundation, supported by the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiative of Umicore Autocat India Pvt. Ltd., Shirwal.

The project has been successfully completed, leading to an estimated 40% increase in water storage capacity of the tank. The intervention is expected to

- Enhance water storage capacity
- Improve groundwater levels in nearby wells
- Increase availability of water for irrigation and domestic use

It also highlights the importance of convergence between Umicore's CSR support and community participation in promoting sustainable water resource management and rural development.

The project was handed over to Grampanchayat, Atit on 18th March 2026 in a ceremony blessed by Mr. Gajanan Raut - Director and Mr. Rajiv Kadam from UMICORE Autocat India Pvt. Ltd.

EMPOWERING RURAL YOUTH THROUGH VOCATIONAL TRAINING: YOUTHBUILD FOUNDATION'S CSR INITIATIVE IN RATNAGIRI SUPPORTED BY IDBI BANK



YouthBuild Foundation implemented vocational training programs in Ratnagiri district with Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) support of IDBI Bank. The objective of the programs was to enhance employability and entrepreneurial skills of local youth and community members by providing structured vocational training in hospitality, tourism, and micro-enterprise sectors.

The training aimed at building foundational knowledge, practical competencies, and awareness of livelihood opportunities through industry-relevant modules. Total 240 beneficiaries were trained across eight vocational job roles viz. Facility Management Executive, Homestay Host, Restaurant Manager, Tour Guide, Travel Consultant, EDP – Bamboo Products Making, EDP – Cashew Processing and EDP – Fruit Processing.

Proficiency Certificate Distribution was held on 18th March 2026 at Devrukh in Ratnagiri District at the auspicious hands of Chief Guest Shri Prateek Manwani, Branch Manager, IDBI Bank, Devrukh Branch and Mr. Pradip Pisal, Branch Manager, IDBI Bank, Sakharpa Branch. **A STEP TOWARDS GLOBAL LEARNING:
MIS SCHOOL COLLABORATES WITH IKC KSI PUNE**



The Indo Korean Center – King Sejong Institute Pune (Under the Ministry of Culture Sports and Tourism of Republic of Korea), hereafter, IKC KSI Pune, and MIS International School (affiliated to CBSE board) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to promote Korean educational and cultural collaboration for the MIS school students.

- A visionary initiative led by Dr. Eun-joo Lim to integrate Korean language and culture into Indian school systems
- First-ever collaboration with a CBSE-affiliated school in Western India to introduce a specialized language and culture curriculum
- "Establishing an institutional framework for professional instructor support and curriculum research to provide substantial educational contributions"

The program shall go beyond basic instruction by integrating a deep understanding of Korean language and culture into the academic journey of students.

The signing ceremony was attended by Dr. Eun-joo Lim, Director of the IKC King Sejong Institute; Pune, Dr. Monika Chhabra, Principal of MIS International School, and Sanjib Ghatak, Co-founder of the Indo-Korean Center.



As a specialized educator and head of a public institution, Dr. Lim intends to lead the development of school-specific educational content and teaching methods. Dr. Lim stated, "This initiative was born from a vision to provide Indian students with a professional and sustainable path to learning Korean language and culture. Our goal is to research specialized curricula and build a foundation for professional instructor support to contribute substantially to the educational environment."

The program anticipates that engaging with both the Korean language and the depth of its culture from an early age could be a valuable asset for students' future academic and professional interests, including potential studies at Korean universities or career opportunities with global organizations. To achieve this, Dr. Lim plans to observe the learning process in the classroom and gradually refine educational models that are optimized for the Indian school environment.

Dr. Monika Chhabra, Principal of MIS International School, remarked, "In an era where India values global cooperation, this partnership with the IKC Pune King Sejong Institute is expected to serve as a meaningful opportunity to enhance our students' cognitive development and foster a deeper understanding of diverse cultures.

Meanwhile, Dr. Lim plans to utilize the insights gained from this captioned collaboration to research and develop flexible Korean language and culture education models to be adapted for various academic frameworks, including the International Baccalaureate (IB) and Cambridge (IGCSE) curricula.

Mr. Sanjib Ghatak added, "Starting with this agreement, we look forward to strengthening our network with educational institutions in Western India and taking steady steps toward building a sustainable foundation for Korean language and cultural education."
